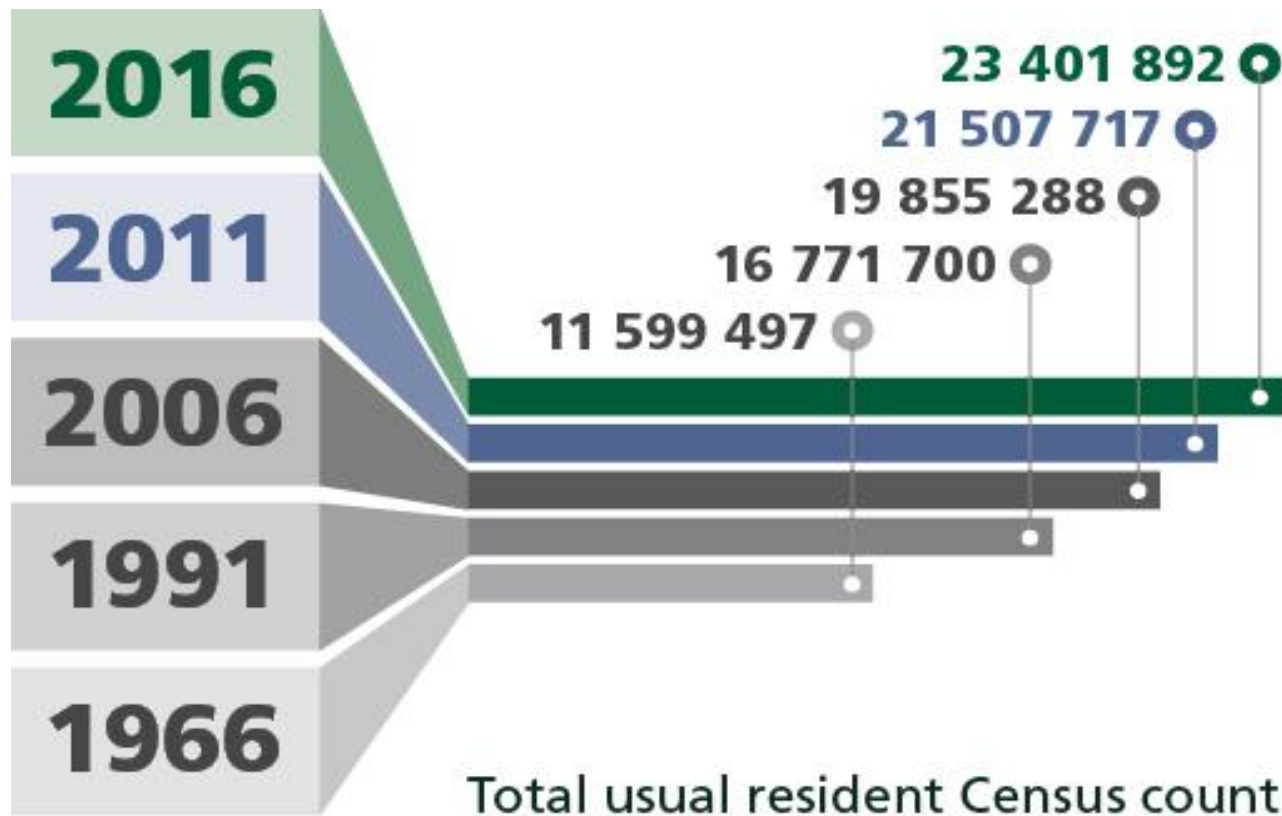

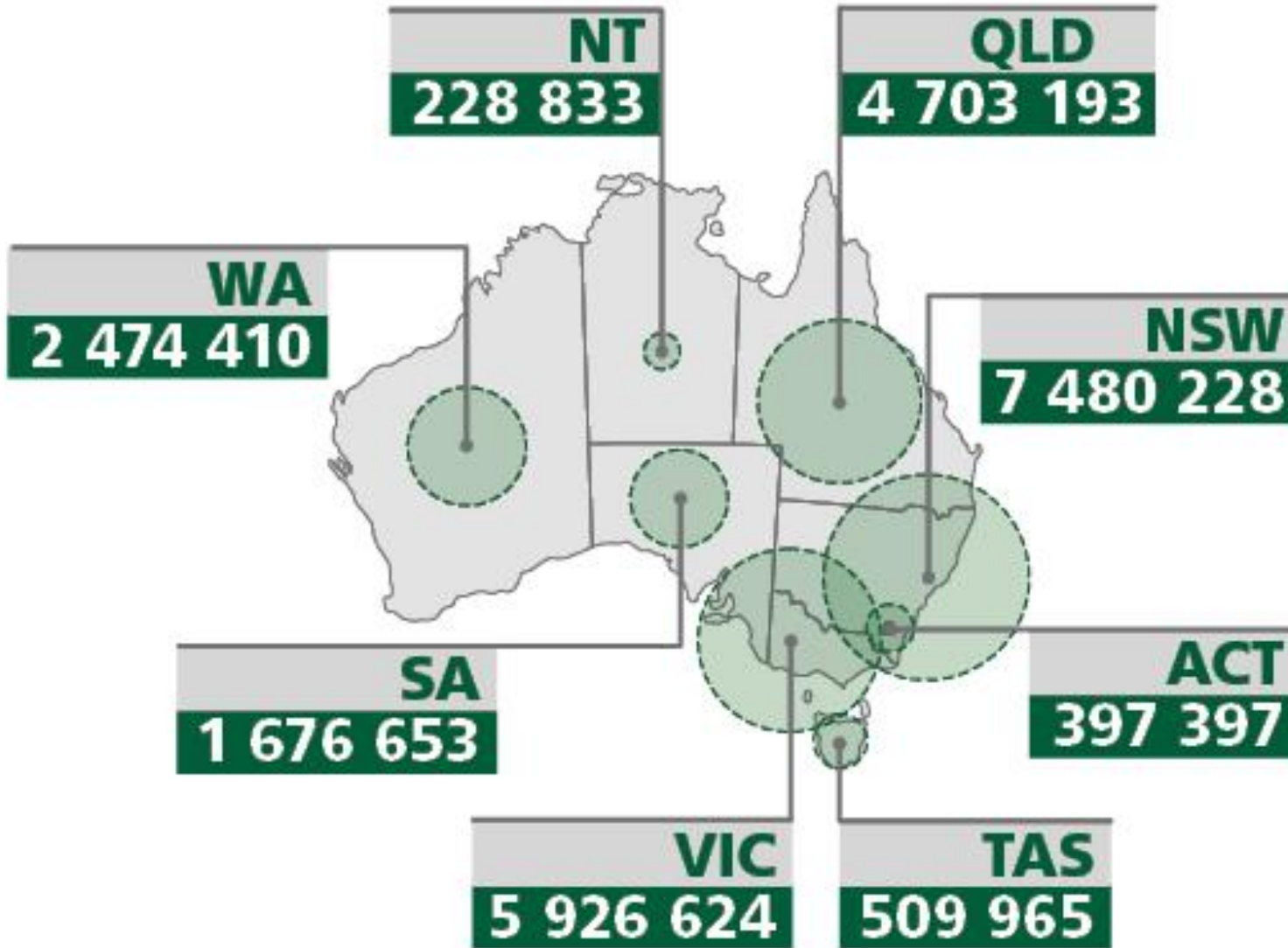

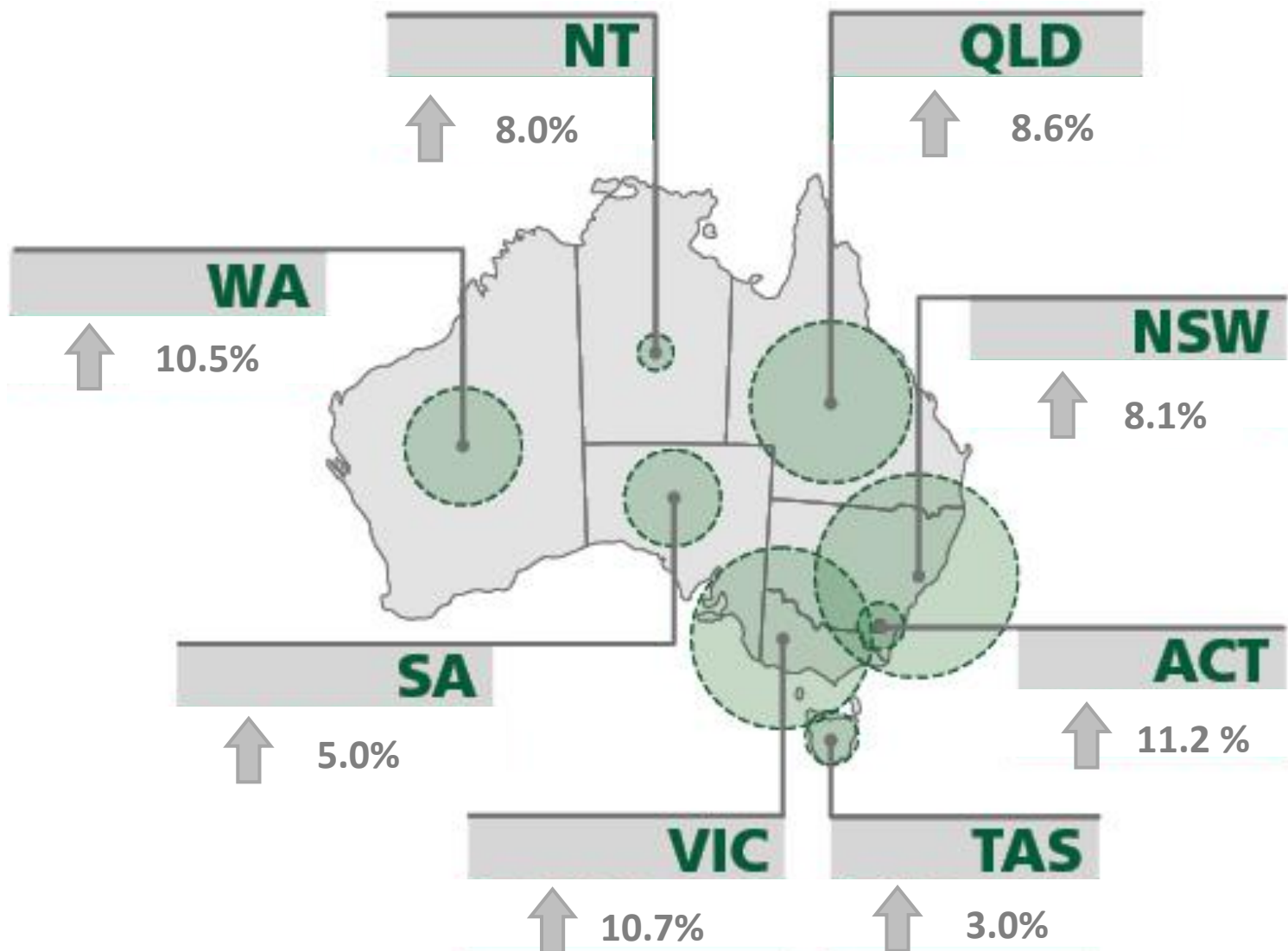

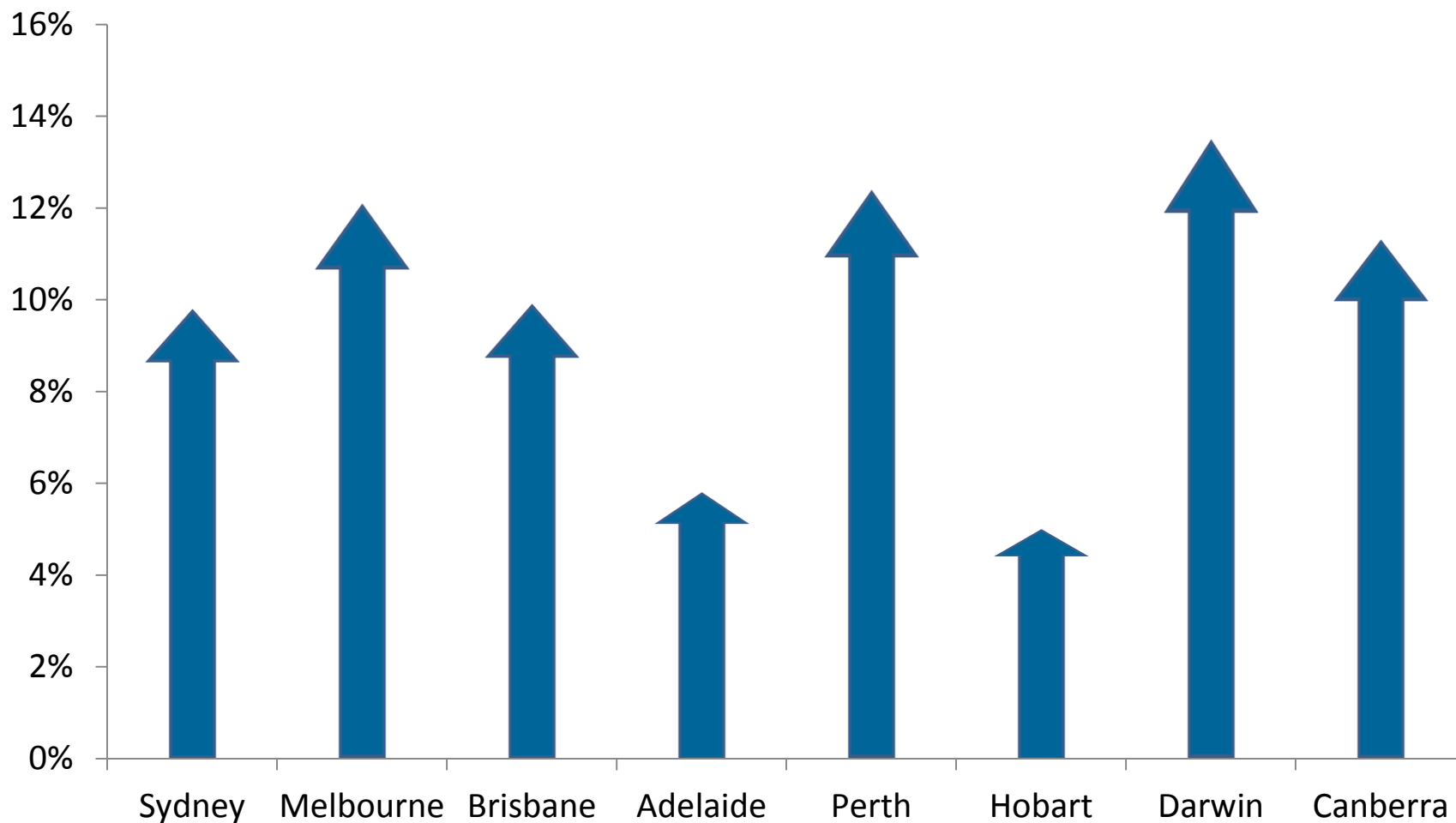

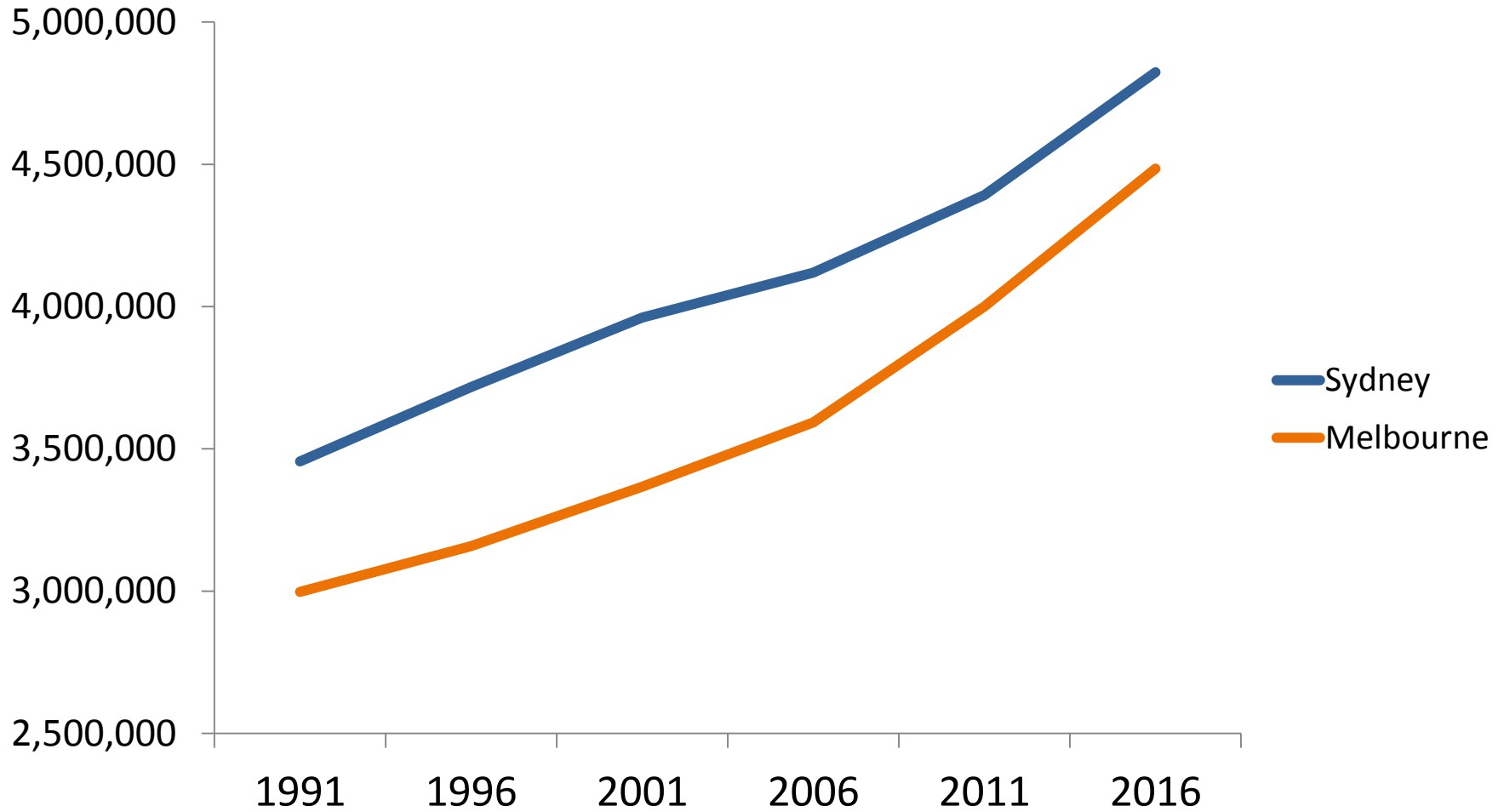
State growth rate



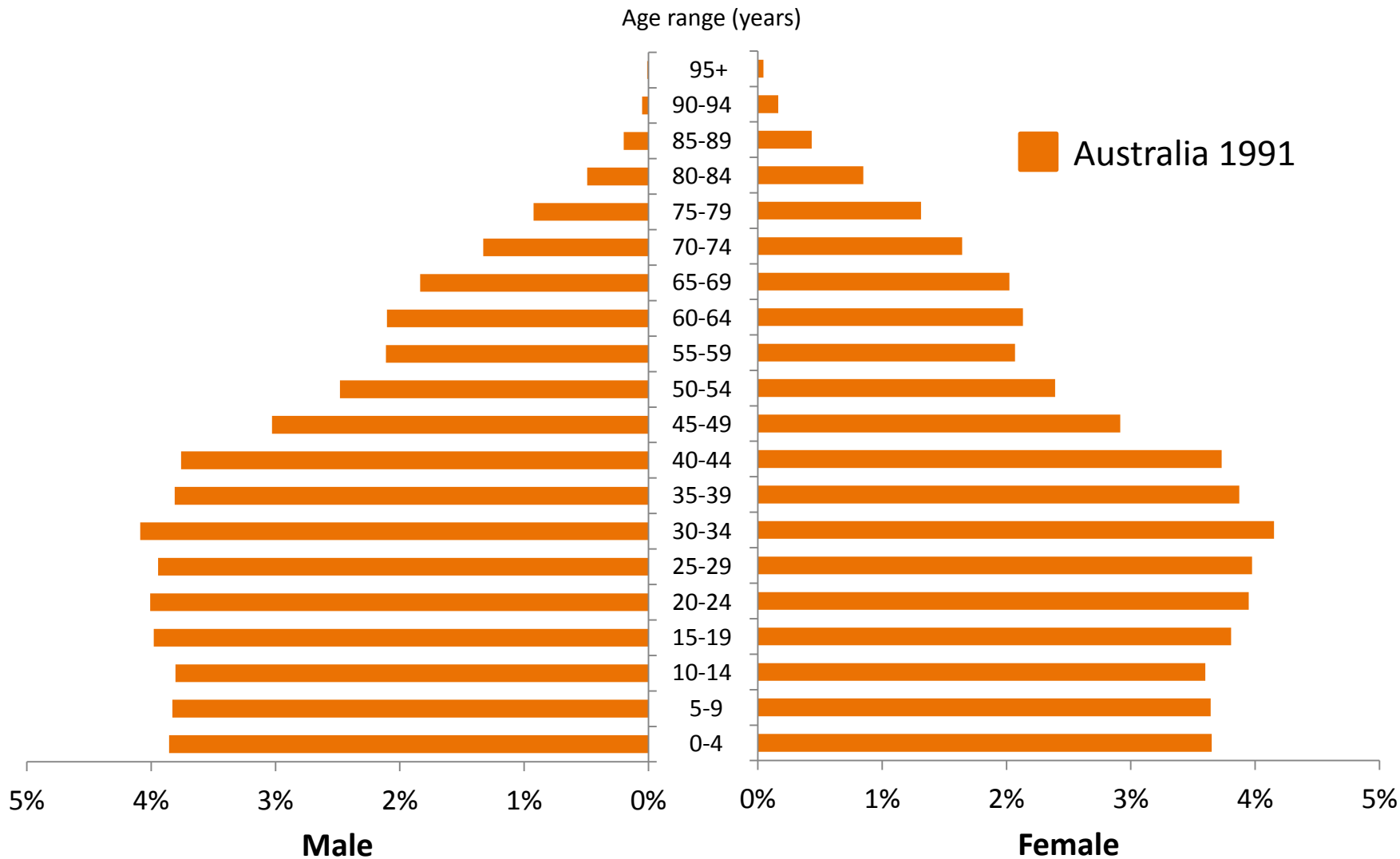

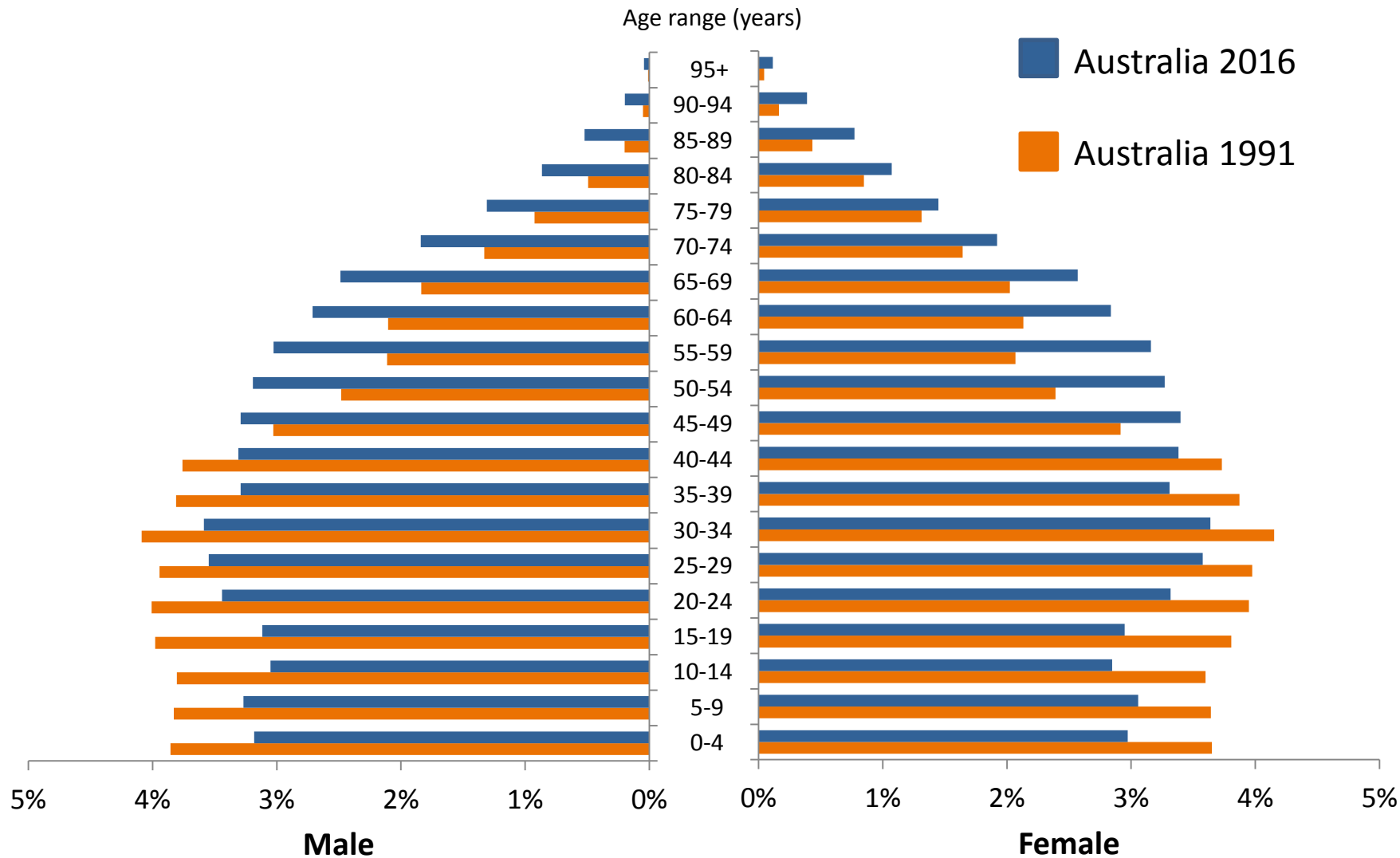

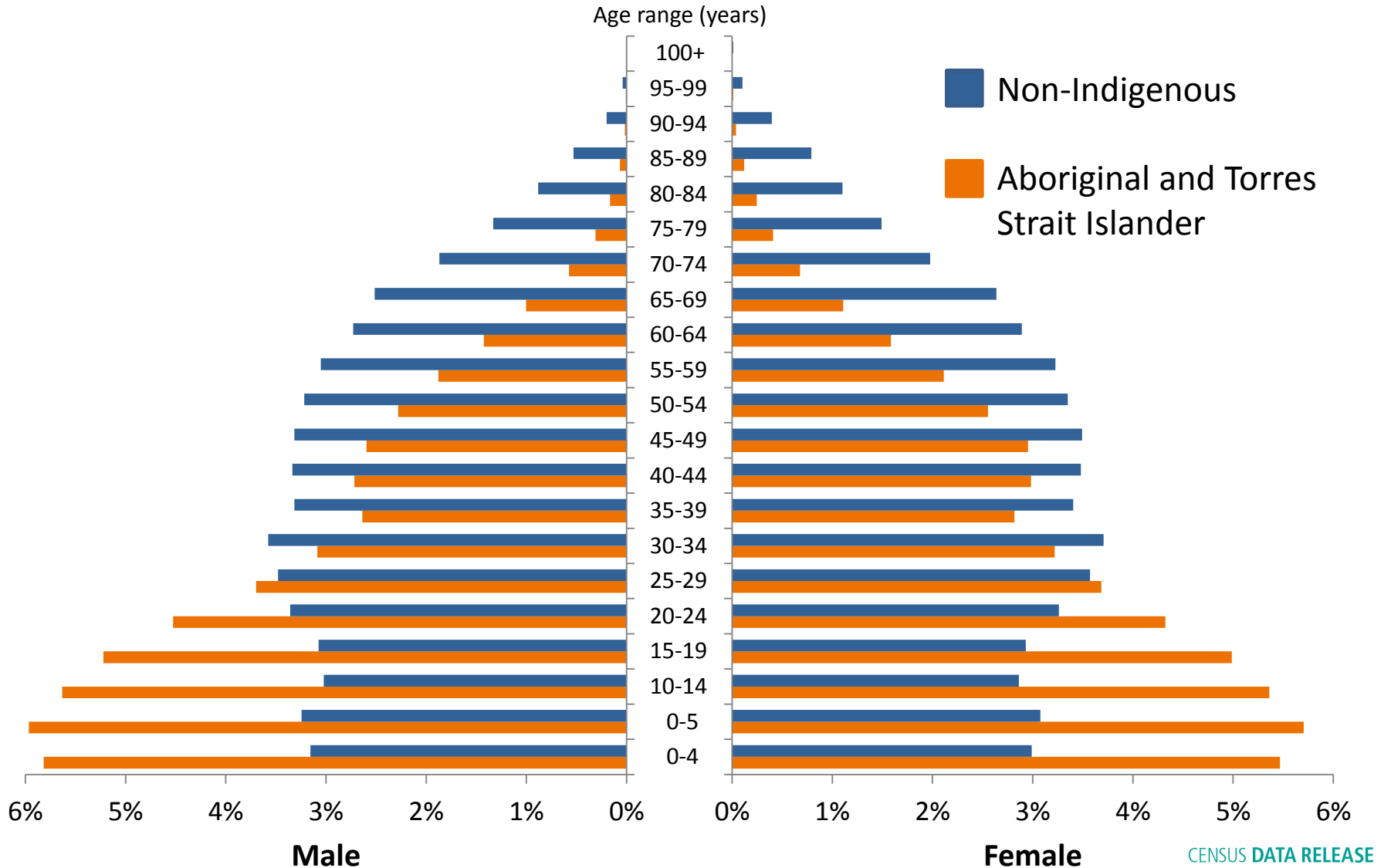

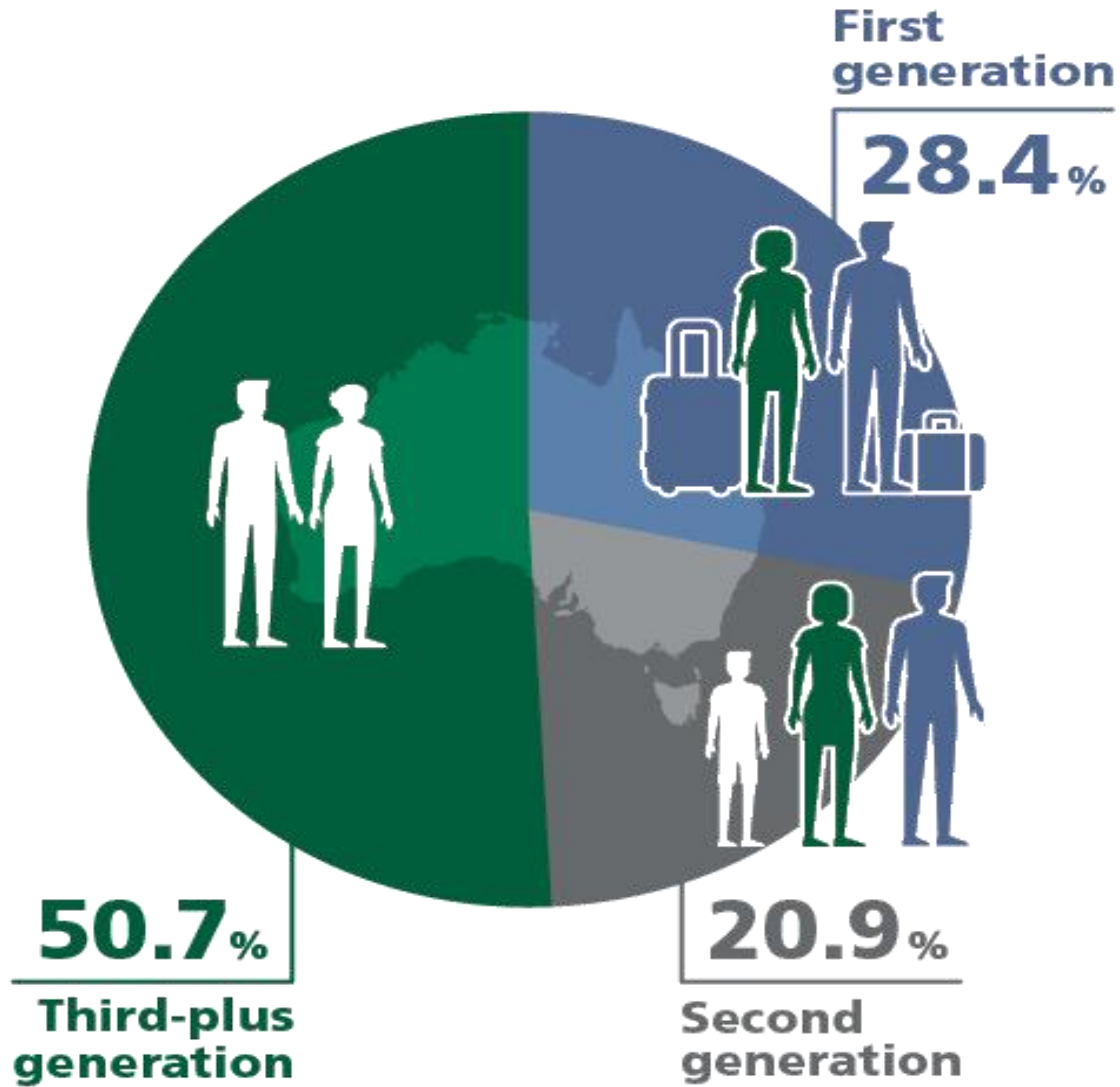

Count of people born overseas living in each state

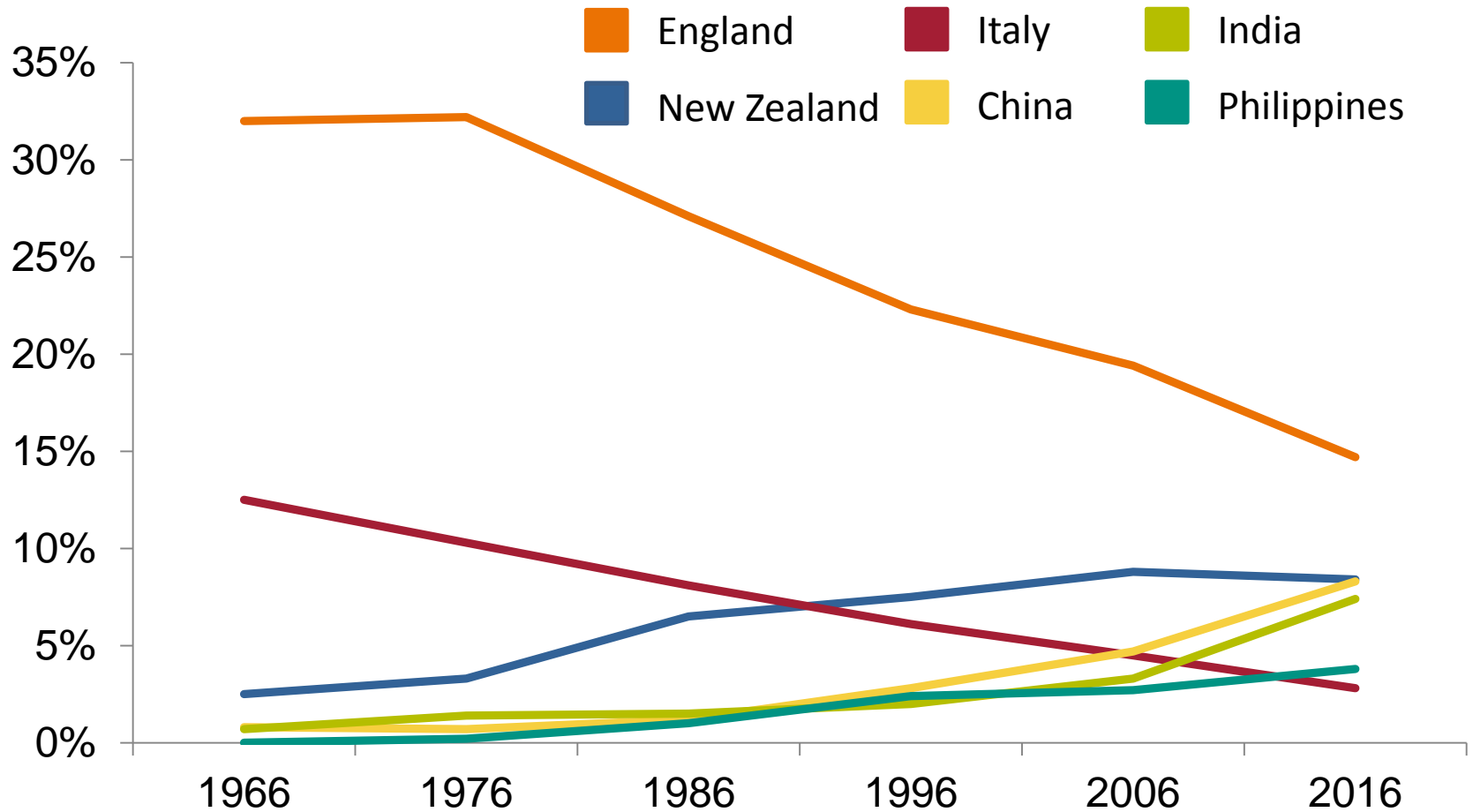

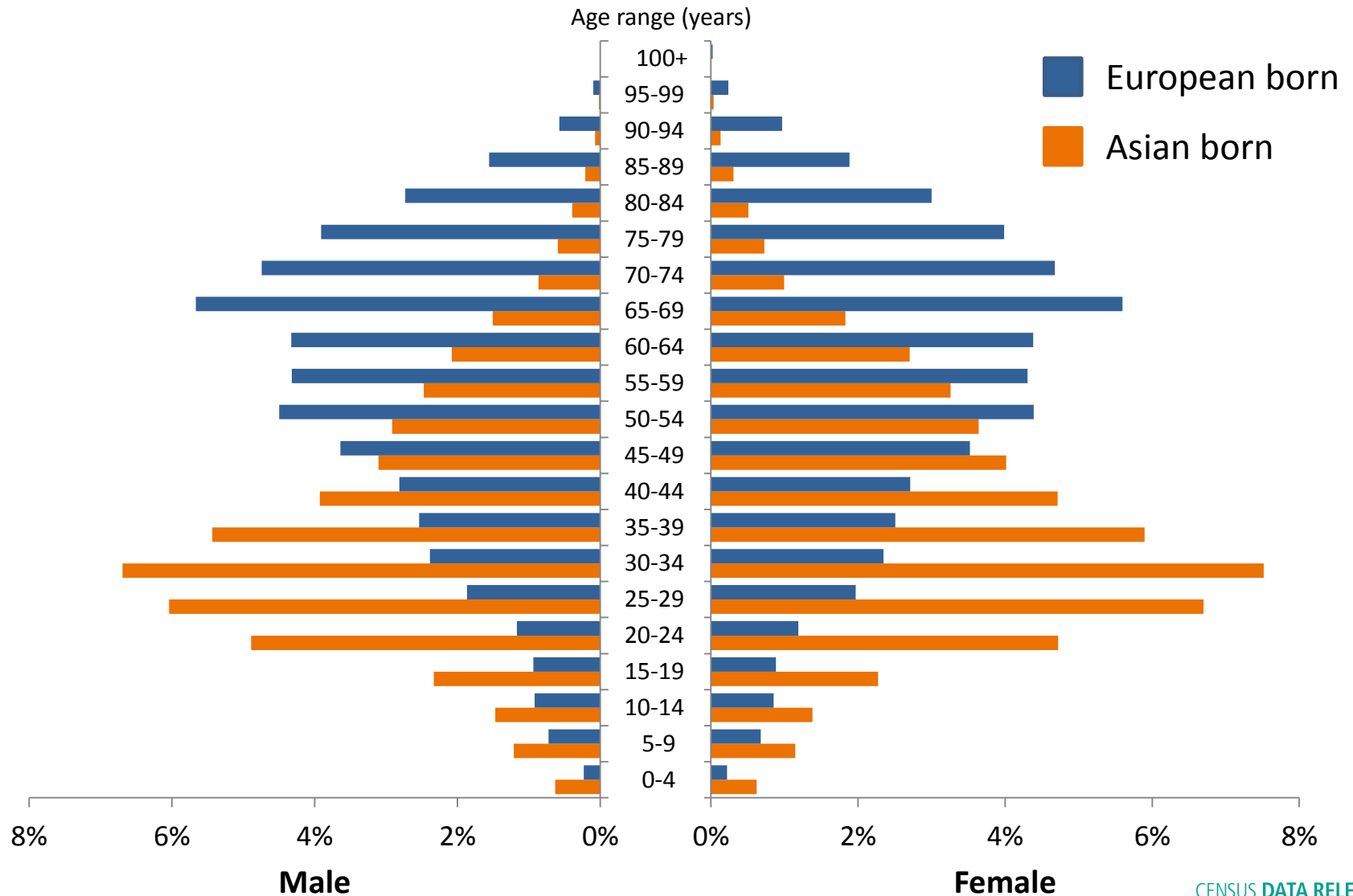

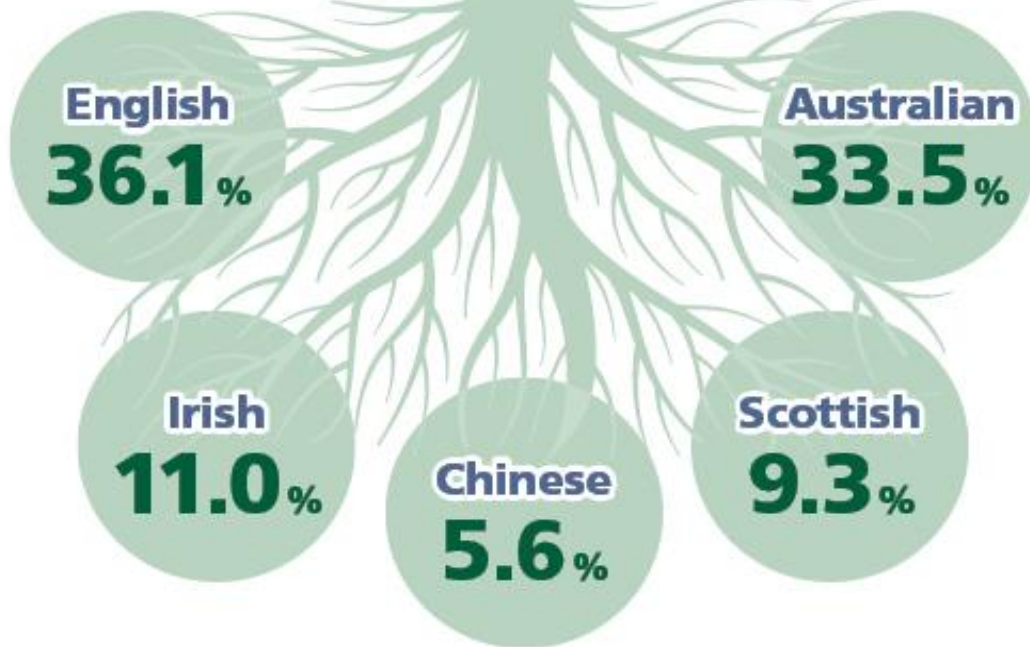

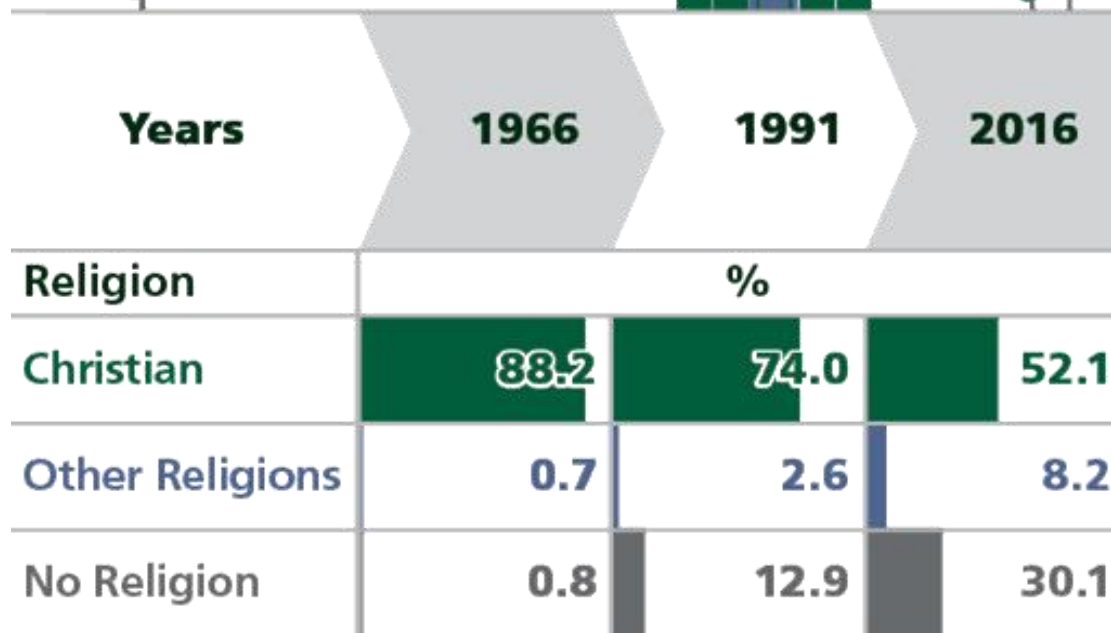
Language spoken at home

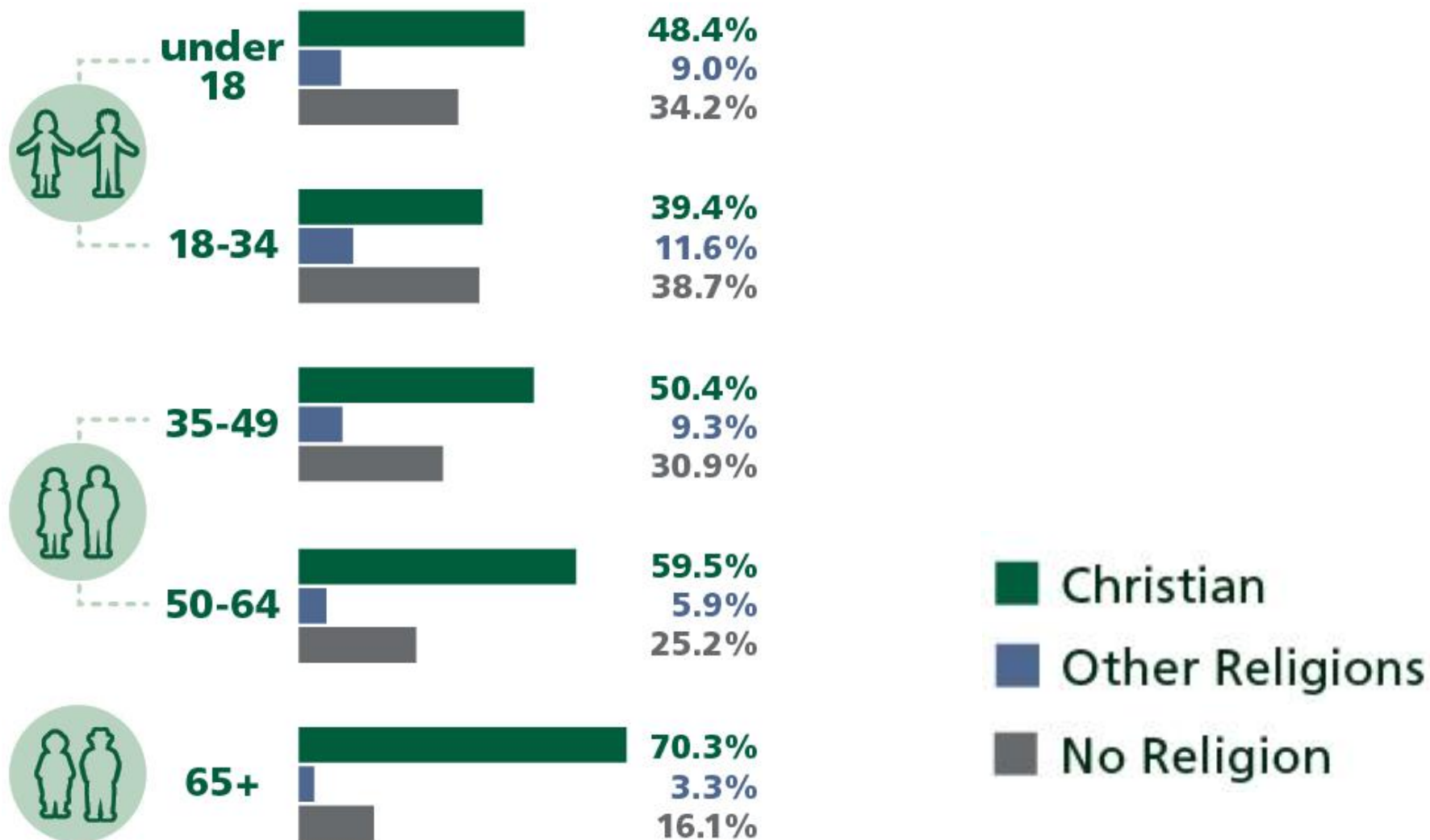

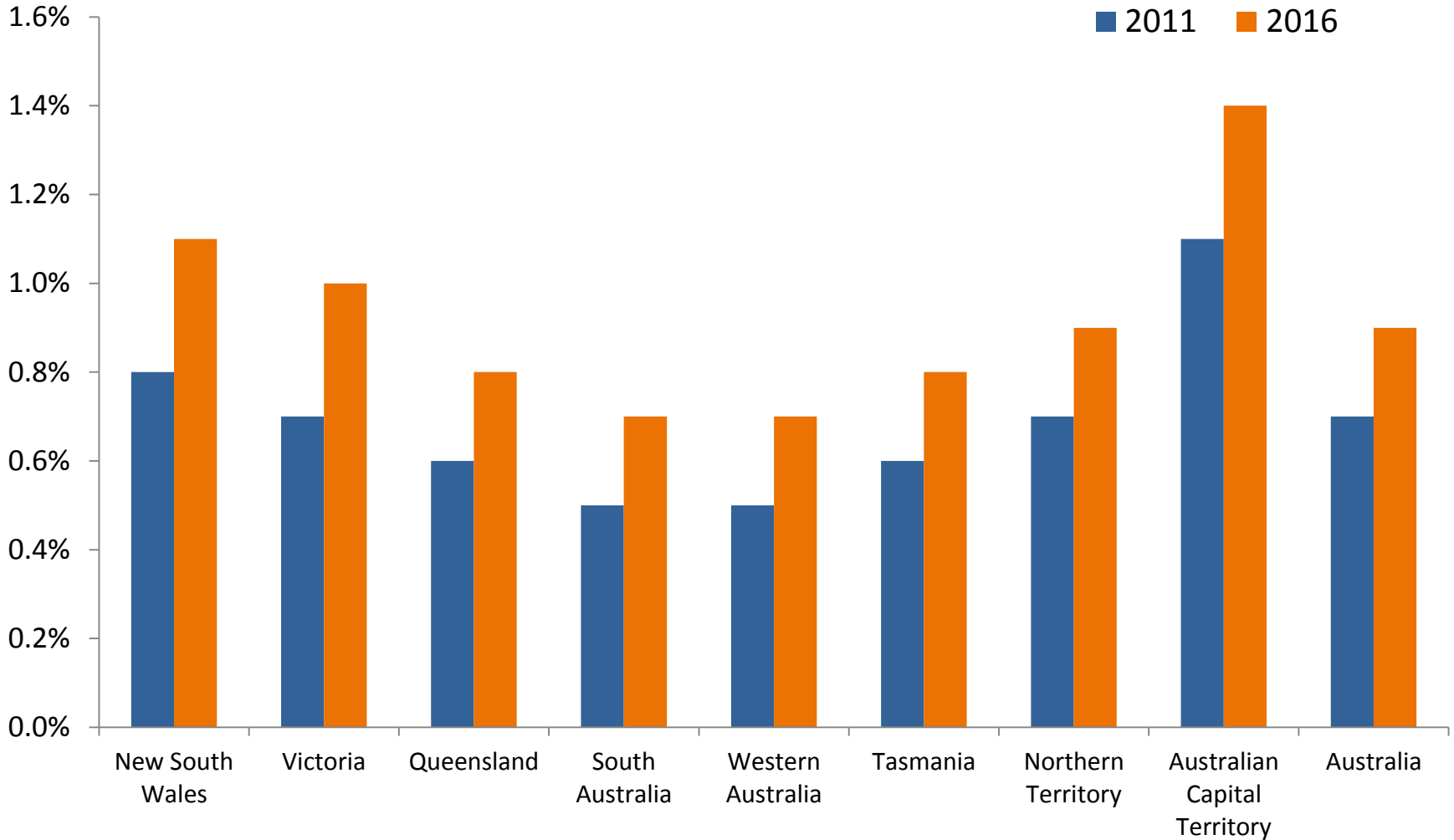

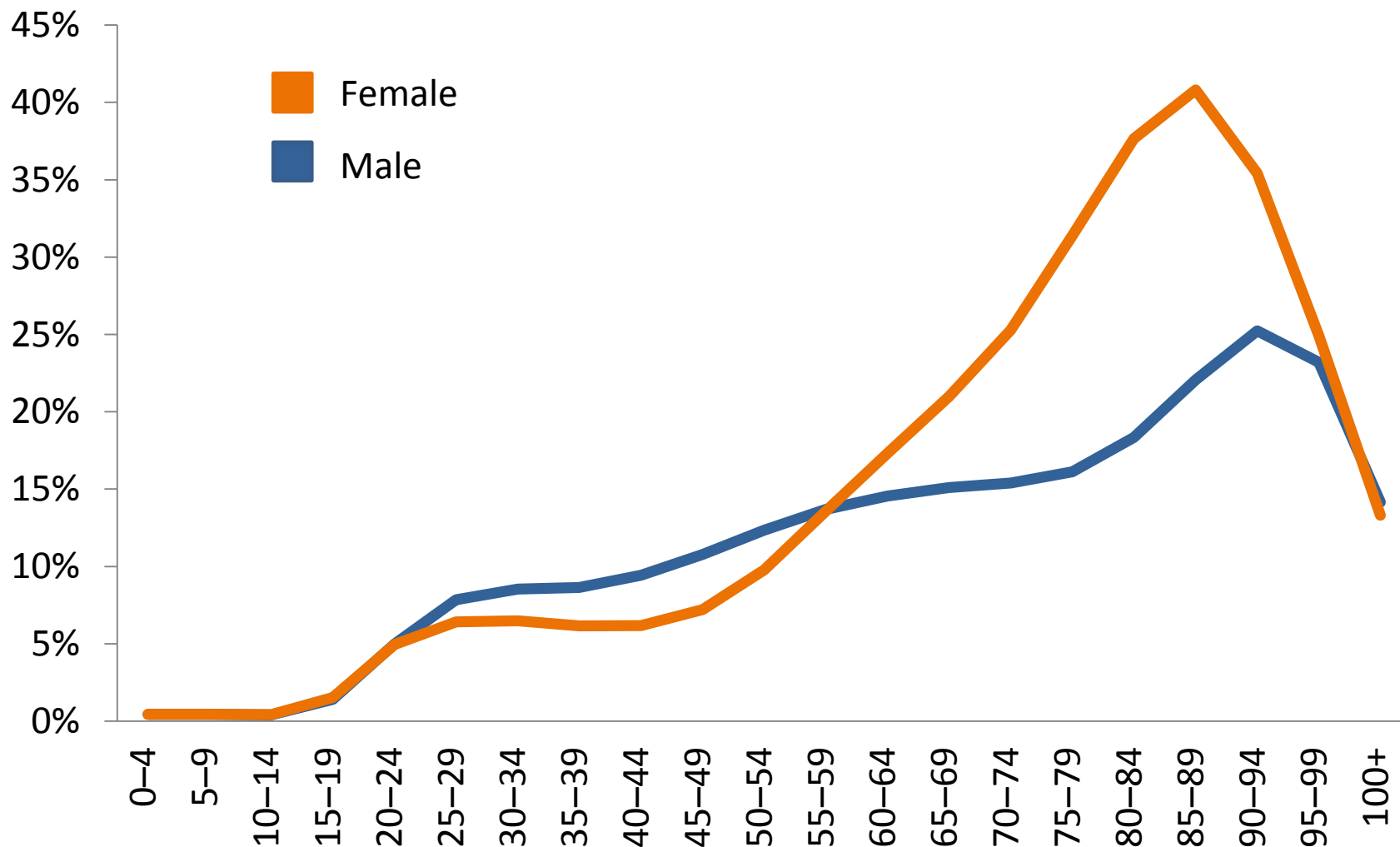
Same sex couples living together



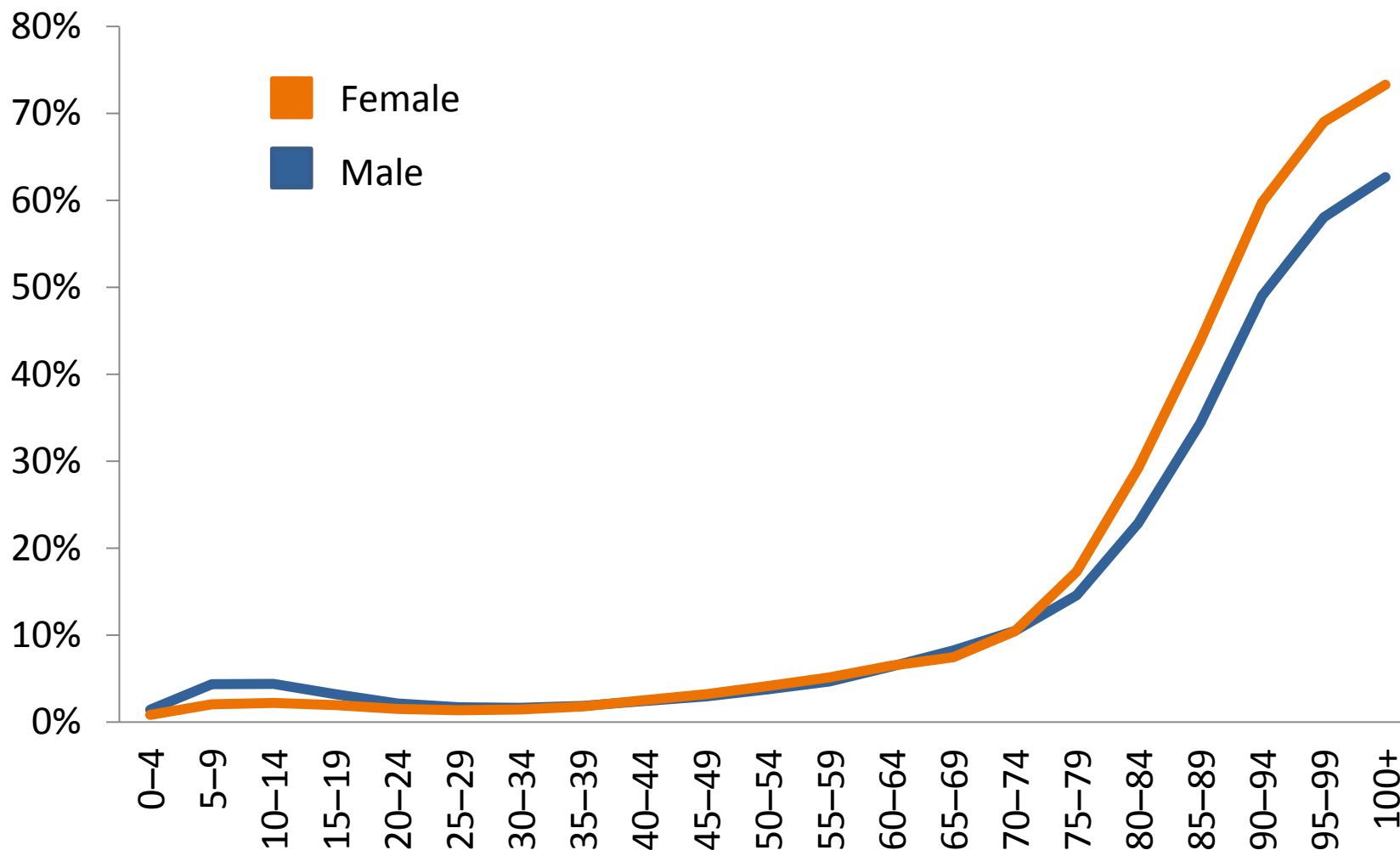
Same sex couples as a proportion of all couples



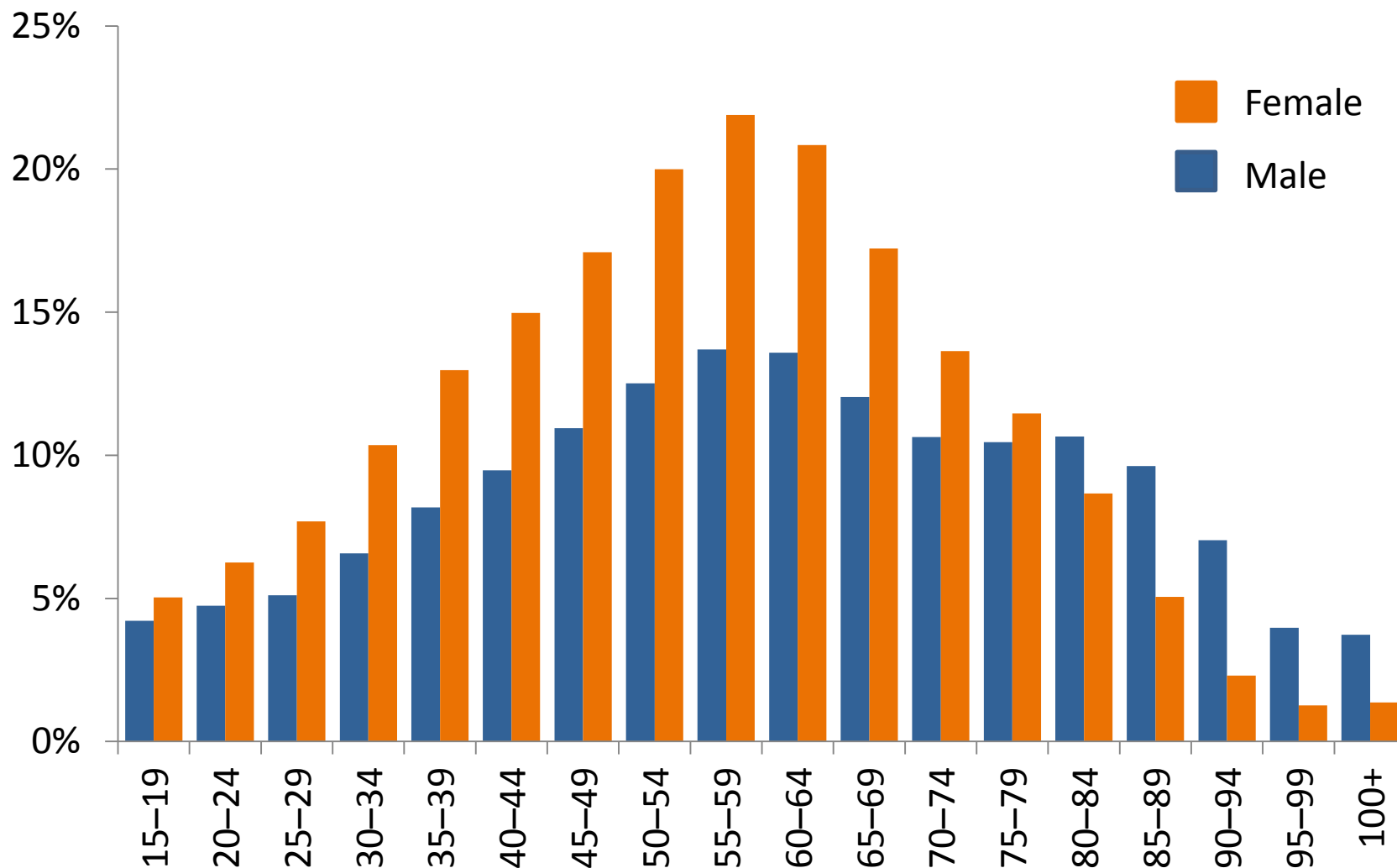

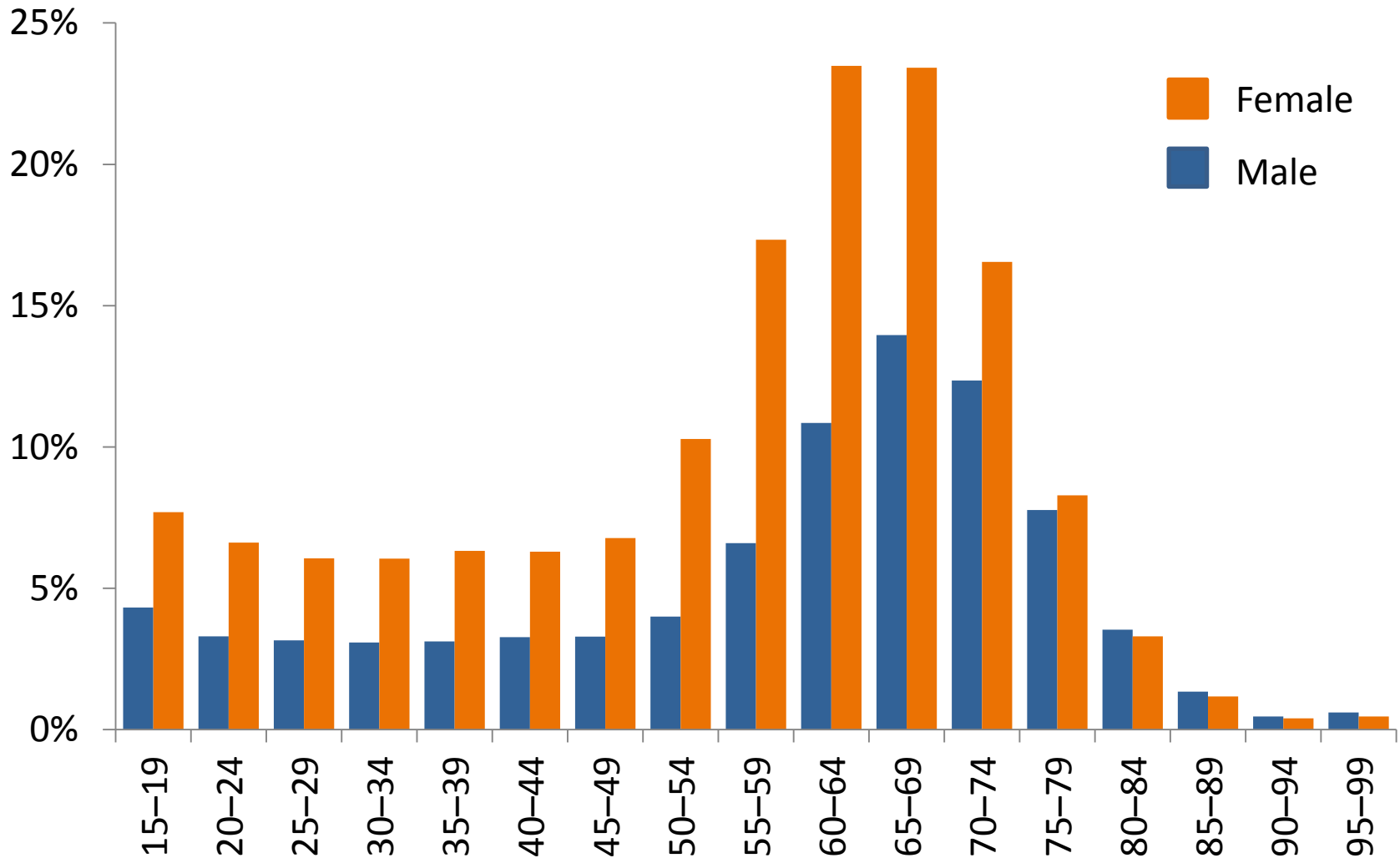

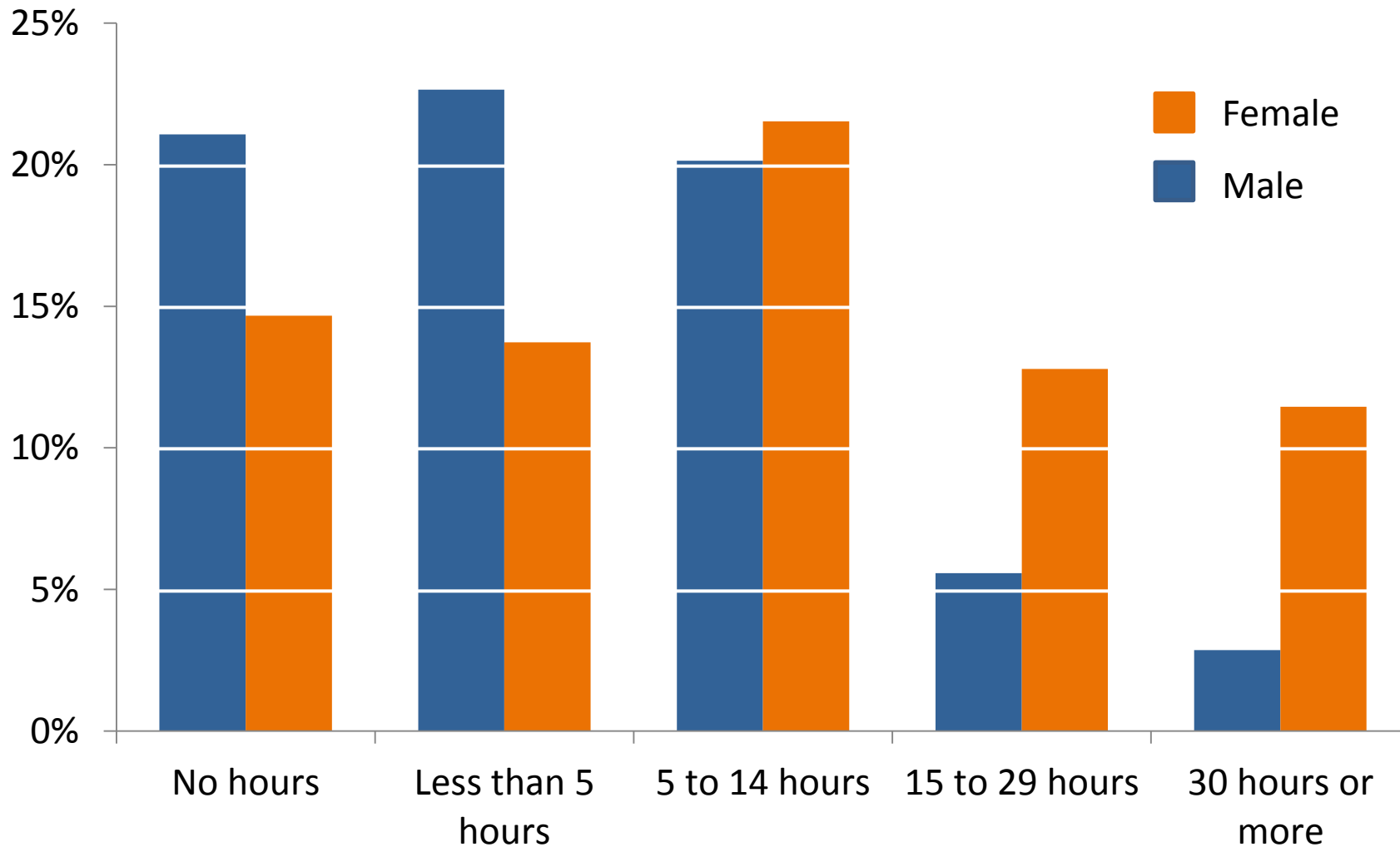
Provided unpaid care



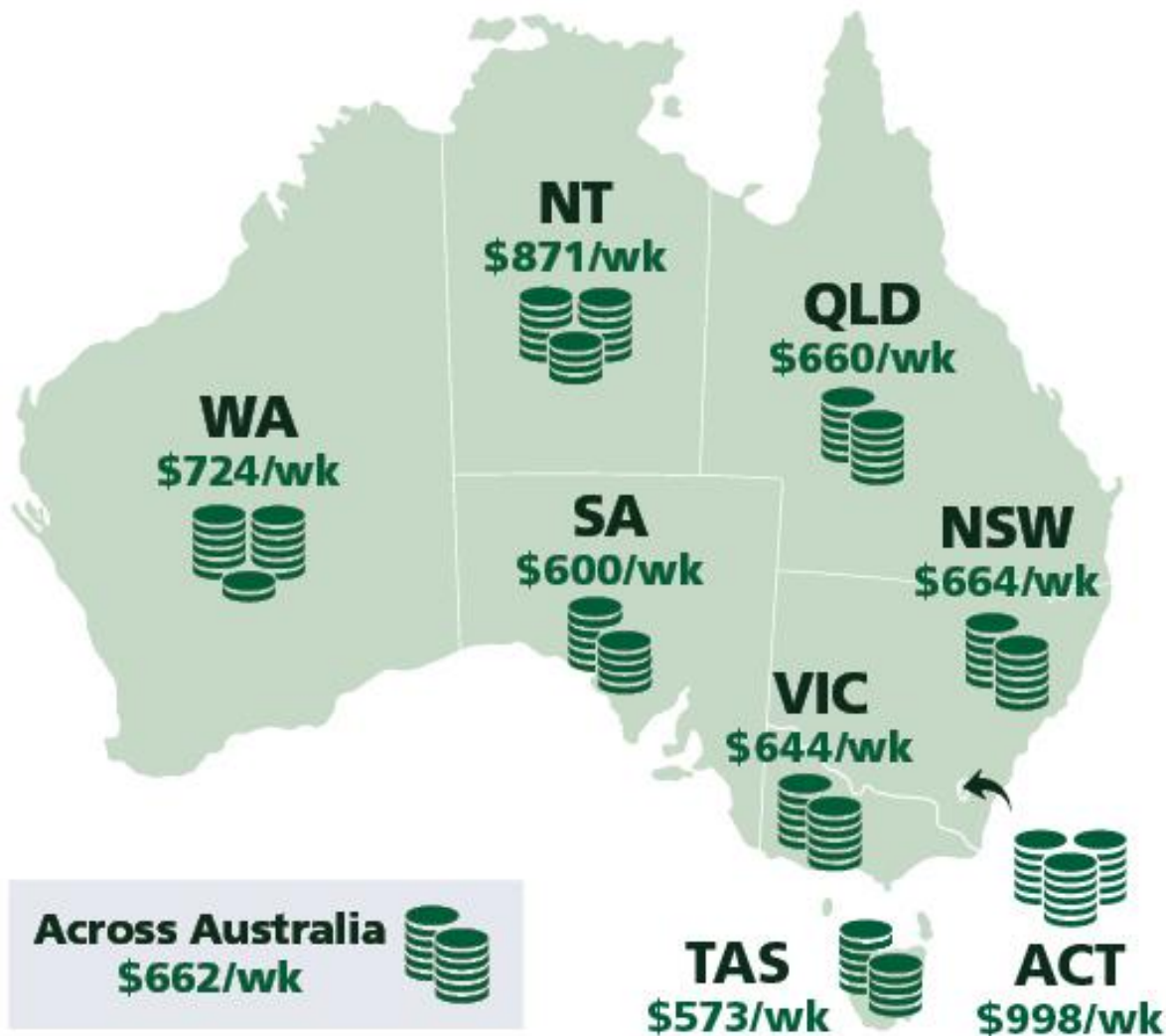
Providing unpaid care for children other than own

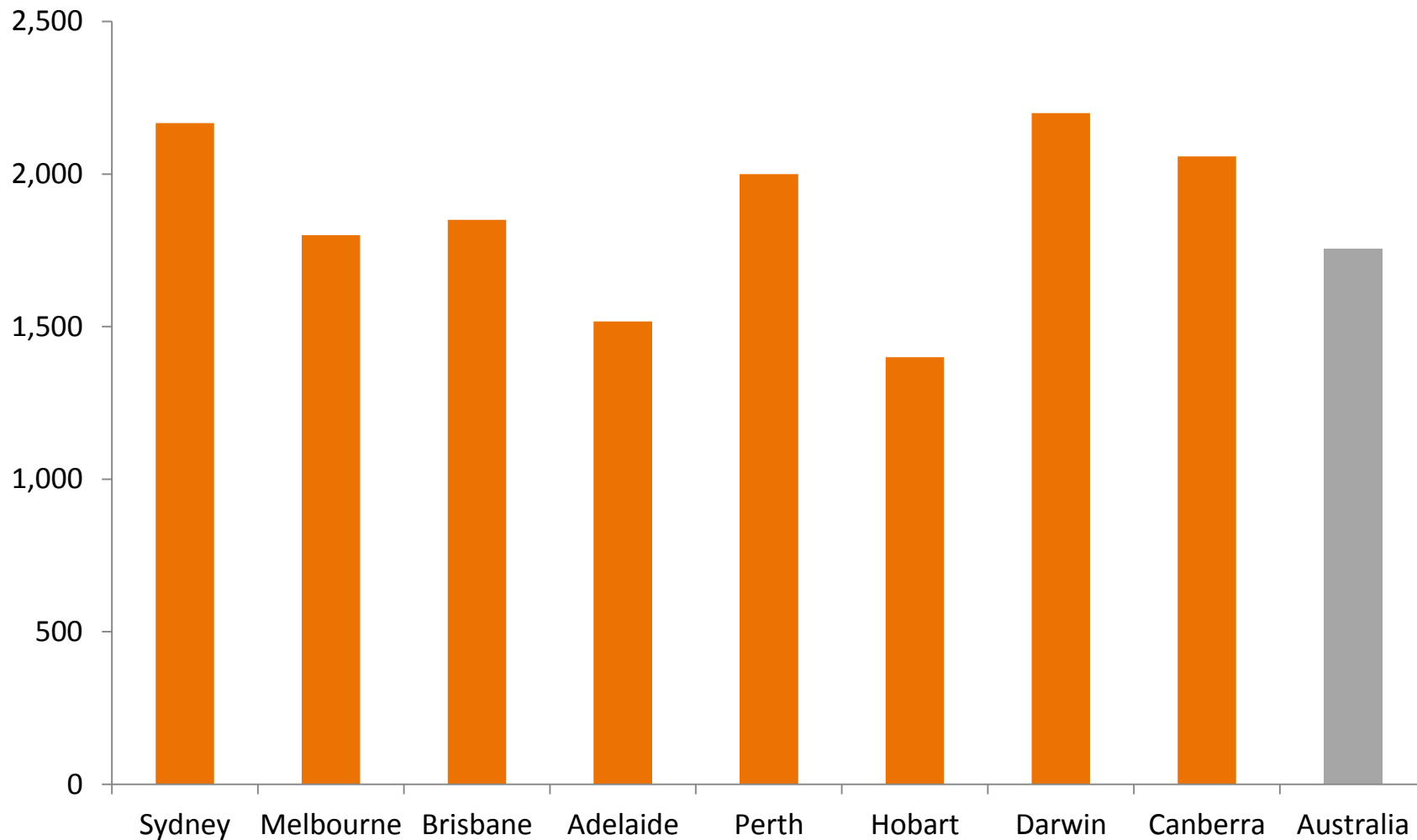

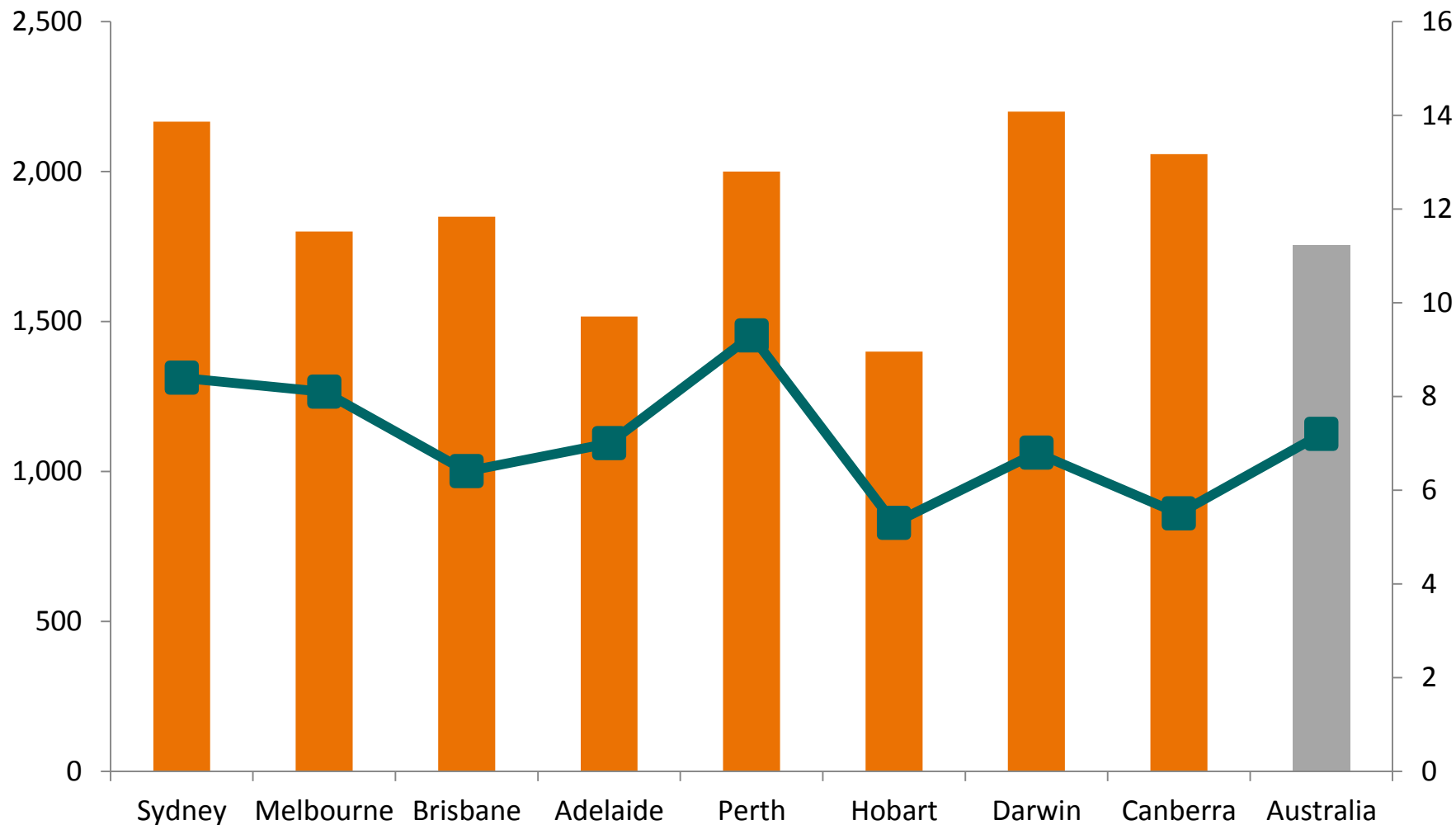


Mortgage repayments and household income

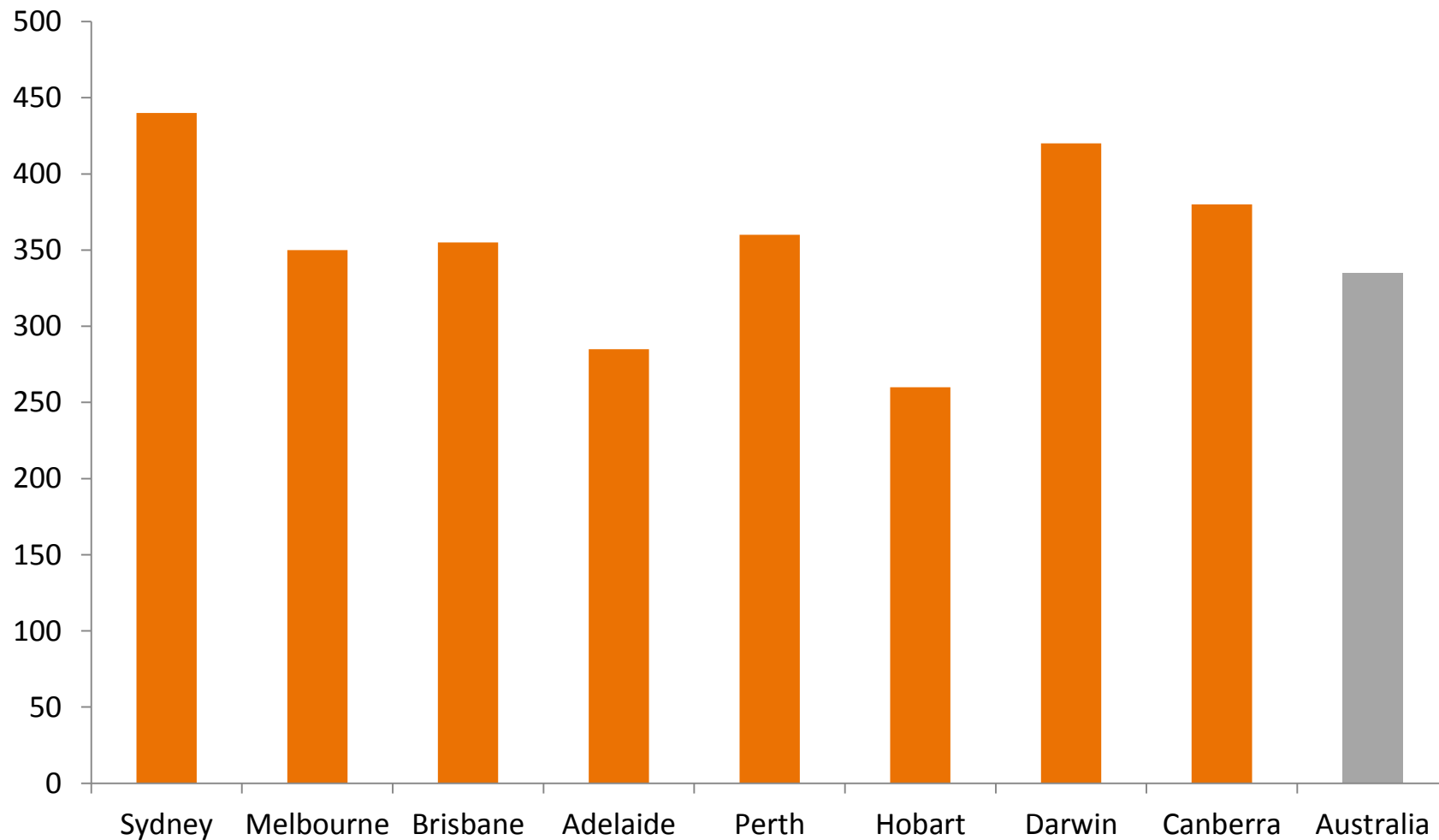
% of households paying

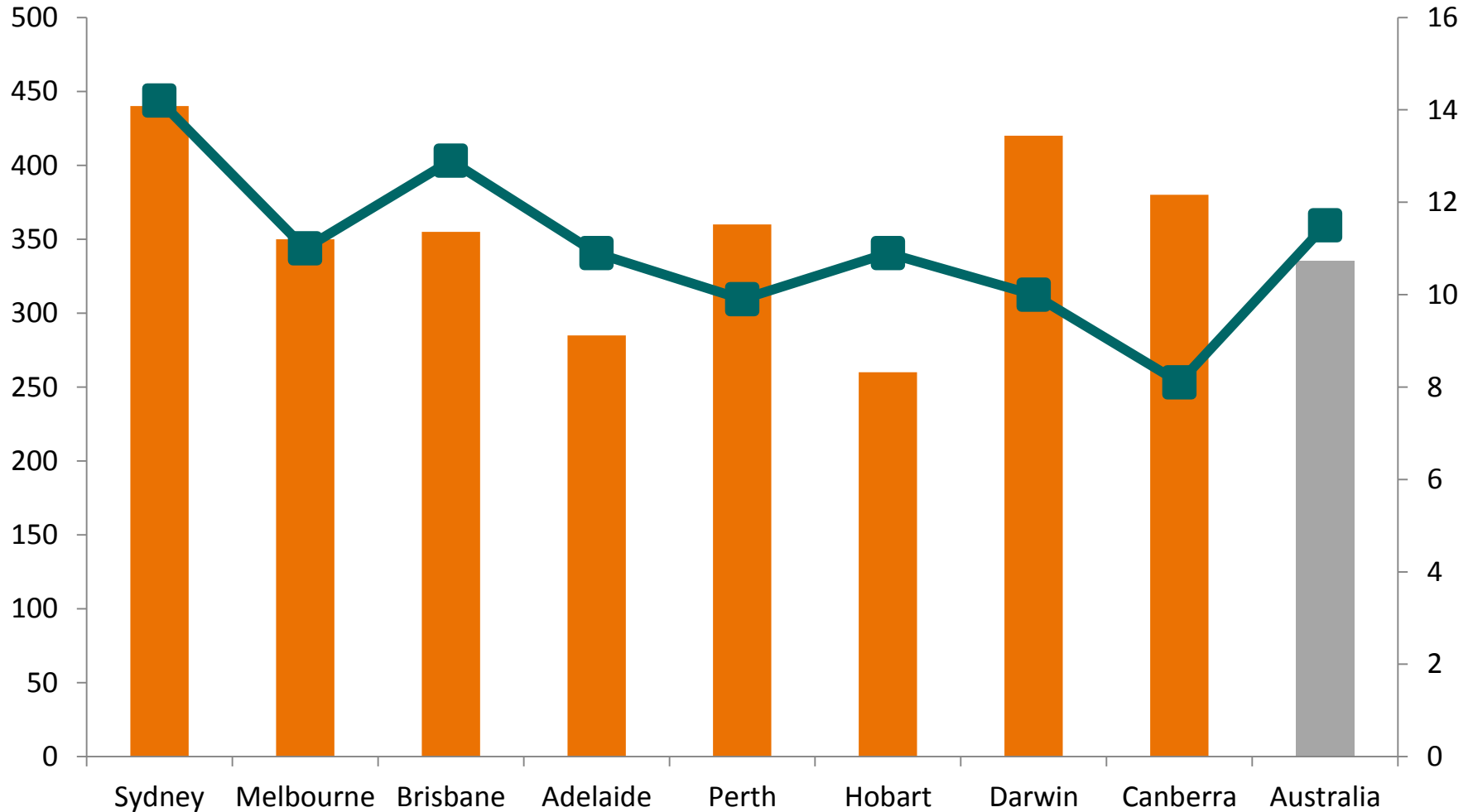


Rent and household income

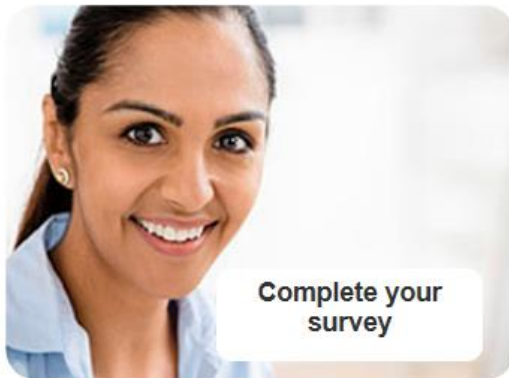
